

# Sky the Blue Griff

## Creature Size:

**Tiny:** Height. 8" Weight. 3 lbs.

## Attacks & Abilities:

**Darkvision:** 60 ft.

**Multiattack.** The griffin makes two attacks - one with its beak and one with its claws.

**Beak.** Melee Weapon Attack: +3 to hit, reach 5 ft., one target. 1d4 - 1 piercing damage. | **Claws.** Melee Weapon Attack: +3 to hit, reach 5 ft., one target.

1d4 - 2 slashing damage.

**Bird Song:** *Action.* Your griffin sings a soothing melody to help revitalize your wounded allies during a short rest. Any non-hostile creature who can hear the performance regains an additional 1d6 Hit Points.



## *Care Tips:*

**Favorite Food:** Insects and Small Berries. They will also consume Soft Nuts and Seeds, but only if the Shells are Removed - as their Beaks are Too Small to crack them.

**Ideal Environment:** Blue Griff's enjoy nesting in open country with patchy vegetation such as meadows and old abandoned fields - it's for this same reason they are so commonly found in the croquet yards of grand estates, much to the delight or shagrin of their wealthy hosts.

**Personality and Quirks:** Blue Griff's are very social, nesting in large groups. Tamed or Domesticated Blue Griff's also seem to enjoy the company of other griff species and people in general.

**Maintenance:** Blue Griff's are low maintenance due to their natural hunting instincts, but regular baths, treats, and petting are recommended in order to secure a strong bond. They are not meant to be domesticated and do very poorly in cages (becoming anxious and depressed, refusing to eat, molting, etc.). Instead, allow it to roam free - a bonded Blue Griff will never fly far and can be recalled with a personalized whistle or click distinct to their owners. They can also survive in cold climates, but will rely on you for sustenance as their food sources do not.
